

Liquid cleaner for coffee brewer units is stronger but safer

The new Abbeychart high-strength liquid brewer cleaner introduced to safely and effectively clean stubborn and troublesome stains on fresh brew and stand-alone coffee machine units eliminates the equipment damages and other dangers incurred by the use of traditional powder products.

Safer for operators and the environment, it is simply poured into the brewer unit and topped up with water before being left to soak and then flushed through on a rinse cycle. Developed in conjunction with Bioguard Hygiene Solutions, it will not degrade plastic components or surrounding contact surfaces as is usual with powders, many of which are classified as corrosive and hazardous to handle.

A special dosing bottle ensures accurate and economical dispensing of the liquid, unlike powders which are more difficult to control and are often over-dispensed by users thinking more is better when it is in fact more dangerous and expensive, with a hazardous impact on the environment.

Biodegradable and environmentally safe, the new liquid cleaner is reported to have demonstrated a superior cleaning capability over existing brewer units in independent trials. It is not meant for bean-to-cup or traditional coffee machines.
